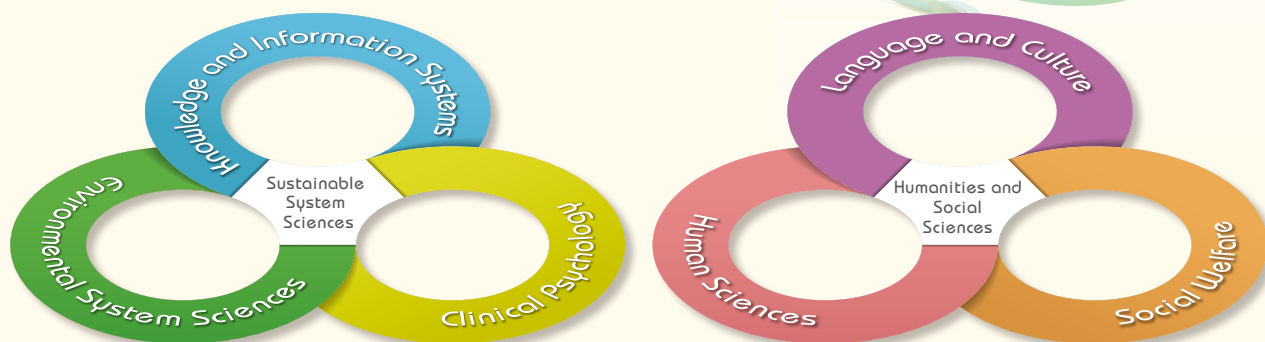

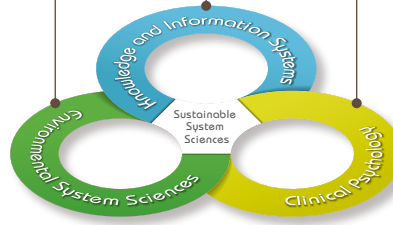


## Department of Sustainable System Sciences

We will develop human resources who have acquired system design skills to create new value, scientific analytical and thinking skills that can respond to technological advances and social change.

There are three courses in Environmental System Sciences:  
 "Environmental Science" focusing on the relationship between humans and nature;  
 "Social System" with emphasis on the connection between people; and  
 "Cognition and Human Behavior" focusing on the connection between human mind and the environment.  
 We will develop human resources who can contribute to the construction of sustainable social systems using their specialized knowledge and skills.



From the view point that the psyche exists not by itself, but in close interaction with natural and social environments, we examine the relationship between the psyche and the environments from trans-regional perspectives, which exceed the traditional framework of the human science, to foster clinical psychologists who are capable to cope with diverse psychological problems in the 21 century. Graduates are expected to work in mental health fields in the future, such that the curriculum corresponds to the graduate programs for certification of clinical psychologists with emphasis on clinical trainings in actual clinical settings. The Japanese ability in communication is required for successful completion of the program.

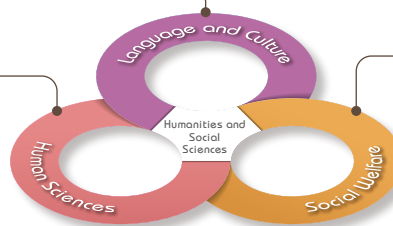
